

Center Stage Expectations

1. You will participate somehow in every show. This can mean you usher for the weekend at minimum, to being a stage manager or lead at maximum, but you are required to participate in every production.
2. You will be an active member of our thespian troupe and pay yearly dues.
3. You will buy a Center Stage polo to wear at Center Stage specific events
4. Buy and/or sell ads for our production programs
5. You will participate in at least one recruiting event with our middle school feeders. This can be attending a show or various scheduled events during the year.
6. You will be assigned a Theatre IA student(s) as a buddy. It is your responsibility to welcome them to the department and help them with their auditions and adjusting to RHHS and our department.
7. You will see a performance outside of RHHS once a semester
8. Follow department and thespian handbook

All will also be expected to provide the following items/supplies for class:

- Pencils/Pens
- Pack of highlighters
- Notebook Paper
- Binder Dividers (5 minimum)
- 1 roll masking tape/spike tape
- 1 2" 3-Ring Binder
- 1 Package 100 ct. Sensitive Baby Wipes/Makeup Wipes

Actors will be expected to bring and leave in their designated cubby:

- Foundation, contour, and highlight
- Eyeliner and sharpener if needed
- Mascara
- Blush
- Makeup brushes- variety
- Makeup sponges
- Comb and/or brush
- Compression shorts **OR** bra and Spanx for costumes
- Tiny black or clear rubber bands for those with long hair
- Bobby pins to match hair color
- Deodorant- **STRONG**

Technicians/PAC Managers will be expected to bring and leave in their designated cubby:

- Solid black clothing- no logos.
- Planner of some sort that can fit in binder if at all possible
- 8 in c-wrench with carabiner
- Work gloves
- Personal Protective Gear (ear and eye protection) if possible.
